Dear Ron:

A note to thank you for my CATS System. It replaces a Lightspeed ANR headset that I've had since 2000.

I had been looking for a noise reducing system that worked BOTH in the Cessna 182 that I fly and indoor and outdoor sports venues. I work as an audio engineer for radio sports broadcasts as a mixing technician for major radio networks. In radio, you're right there amongst the crowd, not in a truck as in TV. It's difficult to mix properly with all the ambient crowd noise.

The Lightspeed didn't work at all because listening to the the reversed phased "noise" distorted the audio of the broadcasts as I was mixing and sending the completed signal to New York. Since the Panther CATS system doesn't use ANR, but blocks the ear canal of extraneous sound, it is a perfect application. Nothing but clear sound as it comes out of the audio mixer without hearing extra crowd noise. We mix in as much crowd as we want for flavor.

Since I received the Panther CATS System, other than using it when piloting my C-182, I've used it to engineer Atlanta Hawks radio broadcasts and NCAA Regional and Final Four network radio broadcasts. The system will get its biggest test this fall when I start using it for NCAA and NFL football games.
